## General Revelation

Theologians often created two categories for how God reveals Himself to us humans. One is His inspired (or God-breathed) Scripture (2Timothy 3:16 NIV). The other is what they call "general revelation." It is creation itself or what we commonly refer to as "nature." For those folks who live in our world and have never heard of Jesus, they still have within their grasp a revelation from God that says He exists.

Paul wrote in Romans 1:20, " For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse." Paul argued that this creation provides evidence that someone eternal and powerful made it. So he claims all humans are without excuse for rejecting God.

Paul told the Athenians that God created the earth in such a way as to encourage us to seek Him (Acts 17:26-27). David told his son Solomon that if he seeks God, God will let him find Him (1Chronicles 28:9). I'm reasonably sure that applies to everyone who has ever lived.

I know we all struggle with how God is going to judge those who have not every heard His Word. I offer this article as my explanation of what I believe He will do. I want to share with you a quote that was the inspiration for this article.

"Some object to Christianity by arguing that it would be unjust of God to hold men accountable for not believing in a Jesus of whom they have never heard, about whom they have no divine revelation. That is true. But the so-called heathen are not condemned for rejecting Jesus, about whom they have heard nothing, but for rejecting the Father, about whom they have heard and seen much via general revelation." (Sam Storm, 10 THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT GENERAL REVELATION).

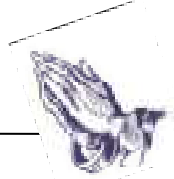
