Budgeting for Spiritual Health

When I was 20 years old and living in San Diego on my own for the first time, I complained to a friend that I never seemed to have enough money for all the things I wanted to do. This friend suggested I setup a budget and stick to it. I found that I had money for all that I wanted to do.

I recently read an article that suggested we Christians should put in our budget a spiritual health category. That makes sense to me. There are many tools we can use to help us in our Christian walk. So here are some suggestions.

Every even year there is a spiritual growth workshop in Orlando. There is a wide variety of speakers and subjects offered. You can plan to stay in the hotel or you can just drive. But you would need to budget the money and save it. You can purchase all the audio recordings from each speaker and class so you can also benefit from those classes you missed. While there you get to sing with a rather large audience (about 3,000). You also get to meet brothers and sisters from other congregations - which translates into extended fellowship.

You can also budget money monthly for buying books. You can buy books that will help you understand the historical background of the Scriptures, books about each book of the Bible that will help you understand what God is saying through each biblical author, and there is also an array of books on biblical topics. Purchasing books to understand the Bible is always money well spent.

So if you don't have a budget you should have one. That would help in the stewardship of your money. Once you have a budget put in "spiritual health" as one of your items and start spending money that will help you grow as a Christian.

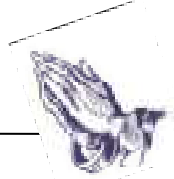
