**God's Vengeance**

God sent Elisha to commission Jehu to "avenge" the blood of His servants the prophets who were killed by Jezebel (2Kings 9:7). Part of what Jehu did was to go into the house of Baal and kill all the worshipers and prophets of Baal (2Kings 10:18-26). When the killing was done Jehu broke down the pillar and house of Baal and turned them into a "latrine" (2Kings 10:27). Yes, a latrine! I guess you could say that shows Jehu's and God's disdain for those who served Baal.

The reason why I bring up this passage is that there was a recent archaeological discovery in the ancient town of Lachish (located in Judea sort of South West from Jerusalem). Lachish was considered an important town in the kingdom of Judea. That discovery dates back to the time of King Hezekiah (2Kings 18:1-6). King Hezekiah instituted massive reforms in the worship practices of Judea. He took away the high places where they worshipped other gods. He broke down the pillars to other gods that the people of Judea had created. He brought back the correct worship of God to his kingdom.

So what was this discovery? It was a "toilet" in the town of Lachish. The toilet was discovered in a room that had damaged altars and pillars. The speculation was that Hezekiah did the same thing to this false house of worship that Jehu did - turned it into a latrine. Some tests run on the toilet suggest that it was never used so its existence may have been symbolic. Still it is a rather dramatic illustration of what God thinks of false worship.

So an archaeological discovery helps confirm the historical accuracy of the reforms mentioned in 2Kings 18 done by Hezekiah. And it serves as a reminder to us that God does not deal kindly with those who turn from worshipping Him.

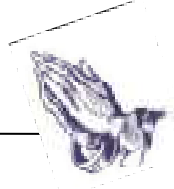
